DRESS CODE

We, at Loggers' Run Middle School, believe that student have a right to attend a safe and secure school where the focus is placed on learning. We seek to provide our students with a reasonable freedom of clothing choices within an established decorum. Clothing should be suitable, comfortable and reflect pride. We believe our standardized dress code will help promote a safe and wholesome learning environment for all students. The dress code is the responsibility of the student. Please read and adhere to the following guidelines.

Shirts/ Blouses

- Any color cotton polo style **collared** shirts with sleeves
- Button down shirts are unacceptable
- No pictures or writing on shirts
- Logos must be pocket-sized and the pocket area only
- Proper fitting with no visible midriff. Shirt must lie well below the waist
- Loggers' Run T-shirts and Loggers' Run athletic shirts are allowed

Pants

- Denim/jeans without holes or decorations. Cannot be oversized, baggy or fading
- All pants must be worn at the waist, with a belt
- No form fitting pants such as sweatpants, spandex, leggings, fleece, velour or yoga style pants

Dresses/Skirts

- Dresses/skirts must be worn at mid-knee or longer
- Slits of any kind are **unacceptable**

Shorts

- Denim/jean, basketball or athletic style shorts are acceptable
- All shorts must be Bermuda or Capri length
- No cut-offs, no sweats

Shoes/Sneakers

- All footwear must be closed-toed
- No open-back footwear

Outer Wear

- Cardigan sweaters with buttons from top to bottom
- Sweatshirts
 - ONLY solid color, ZIPPER style
 - No pull-over head sweatshirts
 - Logos must be pocket-sized and in the pocket area ONLY

General – the following are **NOT** allowed:

- Exposed undergarments
- Exposed midriffs
- Tank tops or tube tops
- Caps, hats, bandanas, or sunglasses
- Attire, hairstyle/color, or jewelry deemed disruptive by the administration

***Spirit Day Attire will be determined by administration.** Dress code rules must be followed. Failure to comply will result in a detention. Failure to comply with the detention will result in a referral.

Students who come to school inappropriately dressed will be required to change. If the student does not comply, an IN-School Suspension will be issued for the day. Parents may bring in a change of clothes: however, the student will remain in the In-School Suspension area until they are fully compliant with dress code attire. All attempts will be made to avoid students missing class time for dress code concerns. However, students missing class time due to failure to conform to school policy concerning personal appearance will receive an unexcused absence for the class.
